The following information and/or changes relate to Request for Proposal #880526, Outdoor Flatscreens for Memorial Stadium that is scheduled for public receipt on July 9, 2009 at 2:00 PM Local Time. • **ISSUES RAISED AT PRE-BID MEETING**

1. LG Model Number: The LG model number listed in the RFP is incorrect. The correct model should be **LG 42LG50DC**.

2. Removal of existing TV's: Vendor will be responsible for removal of all existing TVs from existing brackets. A location at the stadium will be set aside for vendor to use. TV's and brackets will remain property of UNL.

3. Staging area: A staging will be allowed in the west side of the stadium. In addition, we will make every attempt to work with the successful bidder as they bring in materials. Accessibility to work site will be worked out with Athletics, and some restrictions may be necessary due to practice schedule, but basically one will be allowed to work from 6:00am to 9:00pm, seven days a week.

4. Work area: Any equipment that is used shall be done without damage to the bleachers. Vendor is responsible for any/all scaffolding.

5. Question: Are current TVs hardwired into electrical box?

Response: The enclosure is hardwired.

6. Question: Any possibility of an existing TV and brackets taken down so vendors can view bracket assembly?

Response: Yes, one set has been removed and is available for viewing by contacting Shot Kleen @ 402-472-5989. We have also included a set of pictures that show not only the mounting brackets, but also the issue that we currently have with birds nesting inside the enclosures. Any enclosure recommended must address this problem.

7. Question: Regarding the use/age of the existing brackets - - should they be replaced? Also, if existing mounts are replaced, how should holes be repaired...what material?

Response: The existing brackets can be re-used if possible, but should be inspected prior to ensure it is sound. The safety cable to be installed should be installed directly into the concrete above the TV. Athletics will provide an anchoring detail to the winning bidder if they use a different bracket.

• **RFP QUESTIONS/RESPONSES**

1. Question: At the time of the equipment order which would include only the televisions and mounts, we normally would require payment for the equipment (not parts, labor, and installation) due to the television manufacturer requesting payment at this time to build and ship the sets. We were wondering if this is possible because it is different than what the bid statement had stated.

Response: The University will make payments as outlined below:

- 50% upon delivery of all equipment/materials
- 50% upon completion of all installation, testing along with final acceptance by the University

2. Question: Can we propose standard resolution 1366 x 768?

Response: No, we request that you propose the 1920 x 1080 resolution as specified in the bid.

3. Clarification regarding number of submittals required:


- Please submit, One (1) original and two (2) copies of the proposal, marked accordingly, i.e. "Original" or "Copy".

REMINDER TO BIDDERS: This is a "turnkey" project in that the Contractor shall provide a complete, workable, and operational system including all labor, equipment, tools, material, engineering, supervision, licenses, permits and bonds to install the outdoor flat screens at Memorial Stadium.

All other specifications and all notes remain the same.
